Amber L. Sleasman, 33 of Latham was arrested by Officer Edward Ashley, after police were called to a private residence for a domestic disturbance. Sleasman was charged with Harassment for pushing and shoving a former acquaintance.

In other cases;

Muhammed K. Ceasar, 31 of Troy was arrested on a Town Court Bench Warrant by Officer Griffin Hotaling. Ceasar had failed to appear in court to face drug charges. He was eventually turned over to Guilderland Police who also held a warrant for his arrest.

Raine F. Bombard, 18 of Schodack Landing was charged with DWI-Drugs and Unlawful Possession of Marijuana after a traffic stop on Troy Road by Officer Edward Ashley. Driving under the influence of marijuana is in violation of the Vehicle & Traffic Law.

She was charged with DWI-Drugs, Reckless Driving and Unlawful Possession or Use of Toxic Vapors (Huffing Canned Air).
